- Responsible for support of student research projects as well as teaching computer science classes which will prepare students to sit for the AP Assessment. Courses are dual enrolled with Lord Fairfax Community College.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Hold or be eligible for a Virginia Collegiate Professional License with proper endorsements in computer science with experience in teaching high school or college computer science and/or research;
- Master's degree preferred with 18 hours of graduate credit in computer science;

- Minimum three (3) years of teaching experience preferred;
- Ability to balance an interdisciplinary knowledge-based curriculum with a student-centered philosophy;
- Ability to plan, organize, and direct learning activities utilizing technology within a team-teaching environment;
- Knowledge of a variety of instructional models;
- Ability to design, develop, and implement a differentiated interdisciplinary curriculum;
- Leadership qualities with strong analytical and assessment skills;
- Effective oral and written communication skills;
- Ability to facilitate positive working relationships with community stakeholders;
- Endorsement in Gifted Education or willingness to obtain same within a three-year period;
- Ability to exert light physical effort in sedentary to light work, but which may involve some lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling of objects and materials of light weight (5-10 pounds). Tasks may involve extended periods of time at a keyboard or work station.
